	<p>Knowing the disasters that can happen in our Township is the first step in being prepared. Bonnechere Valley has experienced disasters in the past such as, Ice storms, Earthquakes, Wildfires, Floods and Microbursts as well as Power outages, Industrial and Transportation</p>

Be prepared to be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours.</p> <p>You may have some of the items already, such as food, water and a battery operated or Wind-up flashlight. The key is to make sure they are organized and easy to find. Would you be able to find your flashlight in the dark?</p>
